FAQs

What do I wear?

Derby hats and festive spring attire is encouraged, but completely optional! This year Zervas teachers and staff will be judging and awarding prizes for best derby hat/attire.

Can I come by myself?

Of course! We would love to see as many members of our Zervas community as possible for this adult-only event. Come with a partner, group of friends or fly solo- you will connect with friends and meet new ones at the Spring Fling this year!

How about kids?

This is an adults-only event so line up your babysitters now!

Can I buy a ticket at the door?

No, tickets for the Spring Fling are available exclusively online at biddingforgood.com/zervas. Purchase your tickets through April 23rd for \$50/person. Starting April 24th, ticket prices increase to \$75 per person so don't delay! Show your support for our teachers and staff by purchasing an extra ticket or two to sponsor a teacher/staff admission to the Spring Fling. If you are unable to purchase tickets this year but would like to join us, please contact Dr. Beck who will arrange tickets for you confidentially.

How do I bid on Zervas Community Dinners/Parties?

It's easy! At the Kentucky Zerby Spring Fling there will be a bid card for each community event that will specify either:

- a) The # of slots available at a "buy now" price. For this option, bid early! Once slots fill up, party is closed.
- b) The # of bidders who will win a place at the party and the minimum bid increment. No two bids can be made for the same amount. E.g., Bidder A bids \$100. Bidder B must bid at least \$110 (assuming bidding increments are set at \$10). A matching bid will be voided. Winning bidders are those who bid the highest amount without duplicating a prior bid.

I can't make it to the Spring Fling but want to bid on community events. Can I bid by proxy?

Yes! If you can't make it to the Spring Fling but want to participate in any of the amazing community events, log into biddingforgood.com/zervas a week before the big event for sneak peek of the upcoming events . Click on "Order Tickets" and select "Absentee Bidding" to place your absentee bid!

Will there be food and drinks at the Spring Fling?

YES! Your ticket purchase to the Kentucky Zerby includes the cost of an open bar which will be offering wine, beer, and two specialty cocktails! There will also be Derby-inspired appetizers and three delicious dinner stations. Dessert, too!

Where do the proceeds from the event go?

Ticket sales cover the event cost. All proceeds from the silent auction community events go to fund activities like Creative Arts and Sciences, Understanding our Differences, the CAP program, teacher professional development, and staff appreciation.
